Call for proposals for 2020

The committee will be considering options for our 2020 shows at our first meeting after the summer break. We would therefore like to invite all members (and other interested parties) to present to us their proposals for possible shows for the company to perform.

Artistic Vision

The foremost consideration of the Committee is the artistic concept and vision of the Stage Director. What is this show to be? We would like to know which version of a show the director is planning, which time period and style they plan to set the show in, what kind of scenery, costumes, suggested solutions to any perceived problems etc. The more thoroughly thought through a proposal, the better it is.

Practical considerations

Although the list is longer and cannot be ignored, the practical considerations about a show are the secondary concern of the committee.

Good shows for BLOC are those that have onstage opportunities for a number of people, from a wide range of ages and nationalities. Our November shows should be suitable for **family pre-Christmas entertainment**, whilst the May show **may be more innovative or edgy, or may be another great family show.**

The committee will also consider (among many elements):

- Does it have an appropriate number of lead parts (more is better but all things in moderation) and is it conceivable that we will be able to cast those roles from the current membership of the company?
- Does it have enough material for the chorus to perform (the masses get fidgety if they have nothing to do)?
- Is the musical difficulty suitable for a BLOC show - not too easy, not too hard?
- Is the size of the orchestra suitable for a BLOC production?
- Are we likely to be able to sell tickets to this show in Brussels (is it well known, does it appeal to a wide range of patrons, is it about a popular topic?)

What are the staging requirements (can we feasibly build the necessary sets, does the theatre booked have the technical capabilities required)?

The May 2020 show will most likely be performed in De Bosuil - which seats just over 300 audience members, and has (with creative solutions) space for a maximum of around 45 cast members. For our November show in 2020 we will most likely be performing in the Auderghem Cultural Centre which seats around 660 audience members, and we have squeezed in around 80 cast members.

In order to make a proposal for a show, it is HIGHLY recommended that the person making the proposal has spoken to others, and has as many people on board as possible in the following roles:

- Producer
- Stage Director
- Musical Director
- Choreographer (if relevant)
- Rehearsal Pianist
- Stage Manager

A team with experience is always an asset, however we are also looking for people who are willing to coach or mentor those who are new in their roles.

Another relevant consideration is always whether or not the rights to perform a particular show are available. PLEASE DO NOT CONTACT ANY RIGHTS HOLDER YOURSELF - but contact Alexander Just, our treasurer, who deals with all rights enquiries on behalf of BLOC. Alex is very discreet and is happy to make enquiries *the appropriate way* without anyone else knowing, if a proposal is not yet ready to be made public.

If you wish to make a proposal to the BLOC Committee - please email blocchairman@gmail.com by 15 th October 2019 at the latest to let us know the basic outline of your proposal, and be prepared to present your proposal to the Committee in person in a Committee meeting shortly after this deadline.
